understand the significance of striving, and realize that everyone's success requires unremitting struggle and efforts.


The ideological and moral education is skillfully integrated into the whole teaching process by task-based approach.


In pre-class session, students finish the question on line and watch Louis Slotin's video on Xuexi Tong platform, which is helpful in developing students' self-discipline and forming a general understanding of Louis Slotin.


In lead-in session, teacher shows a video of Louis Slotin to students and asks students to fill in blanks through watching this video to emphasize the great actions of Louis Slotin.

教学方法 与举措 In understanding the text session, the teacher advises students to have the extensive reading to do the task of drawing the mind map for the structure. Then students have the intensive reading and do another task of connecting Louis Slotin with themselves, which will improve their reading skill and enhance the spirit of teamwork and an optimistic and positive world outlook.

In moral education session, students review the details of the text and do the task of oral summary of Louis Slotin's story with the help of the pictures. Students are inspired to brainstorm and think about responsibilities of our generation. After discussion, students understand that the stronger the youth is, the stronger China will be. Students should study hard to learn more knowledge, and use the knowledge to make contribution to the whole country.








Step4: Detailed Reading (18 minutes)



Parallelism uses similar sentence structure to express related contents to **emphasize a point**. The parallel structure makes a speech **powerful**, **persuasive**, **thought-provoking**, and sometimes **humorous**.
